Taking a shot to help save a life: Canada Life to make donation to Canadian Blood Services at Calgary Hitmen game

Donation to be made in Nathan Magnuson's name

Calgary, AB, February 5, 2020. . . One local blood product recipient will take a shot to help save a life at the Calgary Hitmen game on Friday, Feb. 7.

As the game's presenting sponsor, Canada Life will invite 19-year-old **Nathan Magnuson** to shoot for the chance to have a \$1,000 donation made to Canadian Blood Services in his name.

• In 2015, **Nathan Magnuson** was diagnosed with high-risk b-cell lymphoblastic leukemia. Cancer patients often require blood products as part of their treatment. To date, Nathan has had more than 120 chemotherapy treatments, 32 blood transfusions and several hospital visits (an appendectomy, pneumonia, isolation, a stroke and two blood clots in his femoral artery). During his treatment, he has lived his life as any teenager would – he's played football with special chest plates to protect his port, skied, mountain biked, hiked, water skied, been scouted as a model and completed summer school. He has four months remaining in his three-and-a-half-year journey.

"Every minute of every day, someone in Canada needs blood," said Jeff Macoun, President and Chief Operating Officer, Canada, Canada Life. "We're proud to continue our long-standing partnership with Canadian Blood Services and at the same time, offer people a chance to make a meaningful contribution to a cause they care about so deeply."
